Presentation

Management Committee

- The Progress Report, as circulated in advance, including Inter-County transfers and gradings was approved.
- Approval was granted for the Demographics, Sustainability, County Teams Management & Panel, Cultural, Hearings, and Divisional Committees for 2025.
- The Rúnaí provided a comprehensive report on the Congress Motions.
- Irish and Cultural Officer, John O'Mahony reminded clubs of the upcoming Scór Sinsear Finals in Ovens on March 7th.
