Management Committee

- The Progress Report, as circulated in advance, including Inter-County results, recent suspensions, fines, transfers and gradings was approved.
- Upcoming Confined Junior Championship fixtures were noted, and the Quarter-Final draws were conducted. These will be shared with clubs in due course.
- Irish and Cultural Officer, John O'Mahony congratulated Millstreet on winning the 2025 All-Ireland Scór Sinsir Tráth na gCeist final.
- Children's Officer, Donal McCarthy reminded clubs of the May 12th deadline for the submission of Club Safety Statements, along with the possible GAA sanctions for non-compliance.
