



Cork County Committee Bulletin

17/02/2026

The second County Committee meeting of 2026 took place on Tuesday, February 17th at SuperValu Páirc Uí Chaoimh.

Management Committee / CCC

- The Progress Report, including recent transfers, suspensions and gradings was approved.
- County Subcommittees as circulated were ratified.
- Clubs that have yet to complete the Child Welfare Questionnaire were reminded of its importance.
- The proposed Adult and Rebel Óg Inter-Club Transfers, as recommended by CCC were approved.
- An update on upcoming Scór competitions was noted.

Cómháil Bhliantúil 2026

- Motions for the upcoming Congress on February 26th - 27th were reviewed, with the appointed delegation mandated appropriately.
- Following a vote of delegates, the delegation was mandated to support the motion calling for the return of the Minor Finals to be played before All-Ireland Senior Finals and to oppose the motion proposing to extend the inter-county season.

Club Developments

- Developments, leases and licencing requests submitted by Aghada, Nemo Rangers, Belgooly, Castlehaven, Midleton, Donoughmore and Kildorrery were approved.

Inter-County Teams

- Recent Inter-County results and upcoming fixtures were noted.
- As discussed at a previous meeting, the Rúnaí provided an update on the rationale of the Senior Footballers choosing to play a National Football League game in Páirc Uí Rinn.

Facilities Report

- The Rúnaí expressed his appreciation to Zeus Packaging, particularly Owner, Brian O'Sullivan, for coming on board as a Sustainability Partner to Cork GAA and SuperValu Páirc Uí Chaoimh. He noted various initiatives including AI enabled recycling bins, upgraded bathroom dispensers along with other sustainability measures will be introduced throughout the year.
- The Stadium Event team, grounds staff and stewards were thanked for their work in ensuring recent games ran smoothly.
- The Referees Medal Presentation and Steward's Appreciation Dinner will be held on March 6th.

Council Reports

- Central Council and Munster Council reports were presented, as circulated.

A.O.B

- Independent Teams are Under 13 / 15 were discussed, with the matter reverting to Rebel Óg for adjudication in each case.
- Delegates also raised additional matters under AOB, including players not remaining standing for the full playing of Amhrán na bhFiann, the jeering of free-takers, the availability of match programmes, support for the footballers and the quality of the Premium Level sound system.
