



## **Cork County Committee Bulletin**

### **03/03/2026**

The third County Committee meeting of 2026 took place on Tuesday, March 3rd at SuperValu Páirc Uí Chaoimh.

#### **Management Committee / CCC**

- The Progress Report, including recent transfers, suspensions and gradings was approved.
- A meeting of the Club Affairs Committee with representatives of Ballymartle and Belgooly has been scheduled.
- The draws for the Confined Junior and Divisions / Colleges Championships took place. Fixtures will be circulated in the coming days.
- Planning & Training Officer, Susan O'Brien presented a report to the meeting, outlining the progress of the Cork GAA Strategic Plan 2025-2030, after completion of year one.
- Sustainability Officer, Enda Buckley outlined the various initiatives ongoing within his committee. Plans are underway for the third Annual Cork GAA Clean-Up Day on April 11<sup>th</sup>.
