Management Committee / CCC

- The Progress Report, including recent transfers, regrading, US sanctions, suspensions, was approved.
- Two 'permission to play' permits from Goleen to Gabriel Rangers at Under 21 level were referred to the Carbery as the Championship had begun.
- Correspondence from Newcestown on the County League formats was noted. Competition Regulations / formats will be discussed at the October meeting before ratification at the November meeting.
- Rebels' Bounty results for July were announced.

Club Developments

- Club development proposals from Cloughduv, Castlehaven, Bride Rovers and Argideen Rangers were approved.
- A reminder that the deadline for Munster Club grant applications is August 31st was provided.

Inter-County Teams

- End of season review meetings with all six Inter-County Managers have now taken place.
- A discussion on Inter-County teams will take place at the September meeting.
- The work of the Appointments Committee for underage team vacancies is ongoing.

Facilities & Commercial Activities.

- A report on the Golf Classic at Fota was provided, as well as upcoming events in Powerscourt, New York and the Old Head.
- It was announced that Cork ETB had come onboard as sponsors of the Rebel Óg Minor and County U21 Hurling & Football Championships for the next three years.

Council Reports

- The Central and Munster Council Reports were presented as circulated.
- Approval was granted at Central Council for the FAI Women's International and Munster Rugby fixtures to take place in SuperValu Páirc Uí Chaoimh in October.
- Bere Island's Club status was approved.
- Munster GAA's proposal to introduce a 'Home and Away' arrangement for Munster Senior Club Football Finals between Cork and Kerry was unanimously endorsed by club delegates.

A.O.B

- The Rúnaí confirmed that Cork GAA had been successful in its bid to host the Féile Peile na nÓg competition for 2027 / 28.
- Congratulations were passed to Cork Camogie on winning the All-Ireland Senior Championship.
- Demographics Officer, Eoghan O'Connor provided details on the launch of a rapid growing areas survey being undertaken by the Demographics Committee.
- Delegates raised other matter such as; the VAT rate for clubs, GAA+, suspension notices, cost of All-Ireland Final tickets, stadium signage, loss of sliotars, maintenance in Páirc Uí Rinn, upcoming fixtures, the possible move of Inter-County Minor to Under 18 and the playing of the National Anthem at club games,
